

Virtual Fracture Clinic – Parent information leaflet

Following your child's injury they have been referred for an Orthopaedic opinion.

The Orthopaedic team in our Virtual Fracture Clinics review cases by looking at your child's X-rays and medical notes.

You do not need to attend the hospital for the assessment to take place.

A clinician will telephone to discuss treatment and management.

Following the phone call, you may be given advice over the phone and your child may be discharged. If they require further specialist help you may be asked to attend the hospital on a different day for a face to face consultation or may be referred to our Specialist Physiotherapy team.

Please make sure you have given a working telephone number to the hospital, before leaving today.

You will be called on _____ between 9am and 2pm. We cannot give you a more specific appointment time.

If you are not available on the telephone a message will be left where possible.
